Today, students headed off to Bendigo to visit the Discovery Centre and the RSL. We will include some photos from their day in next week's newsletter.

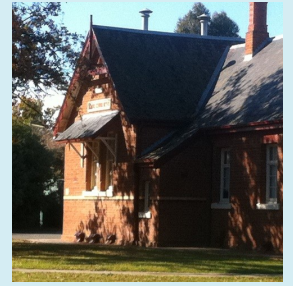

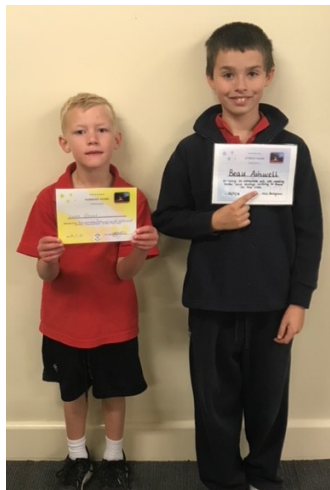
